### Rateable Property:

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council has received a proposal, under section 129C(1) (as inserted by section 6 of the Local Government (Business Improvement Districts) Act 2006 (No. 42 of 2006)) of the Local Government Act 2001 (No. 37 of 2001) from Sandyford BID CLG trading as Sandyford Business District, 10 Leopardstown Office Park, Burton Hall Avenue, Sandyford Business Park, Dublin 18, D18 FK72 for the renewal of the current Business Improvement District Scheme.

[1] Section 129G(4) (as inserted by section 6 of the Local Government (Business Improvement Districts) Act 2006 ) of the Local Government Act 2001 provides that in the case where 2 or more persons own or occupy a rateable property and are liable for rates on that property, they shall be considered as one ratepayer for the purposes of the ratepayer plebiscite.

In those circumstances, the persons concerned are not entitled to vote in the plebiscite unless a majority of them concurs and unless the vote is signed by a majority of them.
